



How will Growth Affect Land Use?

- 19 million acres of forest converted to developed uses from 1992–2020 in the southeast.¹
- The need for services will cause fragmentation.²
- Private, family, forest landowners managing smaller tracts of land that have greater potential for development.³

Renewable Energy

Opportunity if.....

- Restrictive definition in Renewable Fuel Standard (2007 EISA)
- Renewable Electricity Standard not yet determined
- State Renewable Portfolio Standards (24 states & DC) VA is voluntary 12% by 2022 (5 total voluntary state guidelines)
- Environmentalist fear of biomass (Conversion)

Energy Independence Security Act '07: (EISA) Ambiguous language, undefined by statute -

- "cleared before the passage of this sentence"; "planted"; "precommercial thinning"
- Most restrictive interpretation excludes 88% of private forests
- Bottom Line: Adversely impacts the siting of new facilities
- Solution = <u>2008 Farm Bill</u>: "...other plants and trees"





Renewable Electricity Standard

American Clean Energy & Security Act (Waxman-Markey)

- Passed House 219-212 on June 26, 2009
- Included a Renewable Electricity Standard (RES) with a broad definition of biomass. "other plants and trees" and "residues or byproducts from wood, pulp, or paper products facilities"
- Senate E&NR passed restrictive bill in June '09 that did not include climate change provisions. No floor action.
 (*Debate now on if any bill will pass in 2010*)

Clean Water Restoration Act

- June 18 Senate E&PW passed S.787
- Low profile issue at times
 - "Navigable waters changed" to "Waters of the United States"
 - Dilutes silvicultural exemption for forestry operations



- Paper Co. Lobbying 2008: Over \$15 million




