

"What is hunting land going for in the state of Alabama?"


Between November 2004 & September 2005, AFOA conducted a survey of landowners who lease hunting rights on their forestland. The goal of the survey was to develop an average price per county for hunting rights in the state of Alabama. The following results are based on all data received by AFOA. The averages are not weighted by the number of acres involved in the lease. All prices were based on 1 acre & treated equally. We realize that many different factors are involved in each lease. Therefore, we encourage landowners to evaluate their situation on a case-by-case basis. We hope these prices will give landowners a better idea of where to begin when leasing their land.
